FACILITIES SECTOR

OVERVIEW

Facilities Management Supervisors work in a variety of sectors, including Housing, Health, Social Care, Energy, Hospitality, Education, Commercial Properties, Leisure, Retail and Public/Private Sector. Specific job roles at this level may include Facilities Management Supervisor, Facilities Management Coordinator and Facilities Management Administrator.

ROLE PROFILE

A Facilities Management Supervisor is responsible for managing a facilities management service, or a group of services. They contribute to the delivery of strategic and operational objectives and the safe and efficient working environment of the organisation.

They will supervise others, understand contractual requirements and service delivery targets between their employer and the client/customer to achieve service targets.

They will demonstrate excellent customer service skills and be proactive in problem-solving.

YOUR APPRENTICES' LEARNING JOURNEY

Apprentices will complete an 18-month apprenticeship learning journey, which will include achievement of Level 2 English and Maths (if not already achieved). During the programme, apprentices will receive membership of IWFM at the Affiliate grade and upon completion of the apprenticeship will qualify for Associate Membership.

On completion of their learning journey, apprentices will undertake an End-Point Assessment, with an independent iCQ assessor.

Throughout their journey, your apprentices will record and update their progress using iCQ's **iLearner** system, and their End-Point Assessment will be delivered using **iLearner**.
