OVERVIEW

Early Years Educators are highly trained professionals who play a key role in ensuring that young children learn and develop well and are kept healthy and safe. They work in a range of settings, including full day care, children's centres, pre schools, reception classes and as childminders.

ROLE PROFILE

Early Years Educators may be working on their own or supervising others to deliver the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) requirements set by Government for the learning, development and care of children from birth to 5 years old.

Responsibilities include planning and supervising activities; supporting children in developing numeracy and language skills; ensuring each child's care needs are met; and working in partnership with other colleagues, parents, carers or other professionals.

With additional experience, an Early Years Educator can become the manager of an early years setting.

YOUR APPRENTICES' LEARNING JOURNEY

Your apprentices will complete an 18 month apprenticeship learning journey. Their journey will include a qualification such as iCQ's Level 3 Diploma for the Early Years Educator, achievement of Level 2 English and maths and a paediatric first aid qualification such as iCQ's Level 3 Award in Paediatric First Aid.

On completion of their learning journey, apprentices will undertake an End-Point Assessment, with an independent iCQ assessor.

Throughout their journey, your apprentices will record and update their progress using iCQ's **iLearner** system, and their End-Point Assessment will be delivered using **iLearner**.
